

## Police host Tuhoe children

**MORE** than 70 children at the centre of the Tuhoe terror raids have travelled to Wellington as the guests of the police.

The young people, many of whom were on the bus stopped and boarded by members of the Armed Offender Squad, left for the Capital on Monday and will return to Taneatua tomorrow.

A partnership between Tuhoe and police, the trip involves activities aimed at uplifting and showcasing the opportunities for the children's future.

The invitation was first put to directly-affected whanau and schools following the Ruatoki community apology in August, 2014, delivered by police commissioner Mike Bush.
